

Oklahoma Long Distance Race Director:

The USATF Oklahoma race packet is a group of files containing information on forms and directions on conducting a long distance race in Oklahoma. There are about 24 small email files that will be sent to you. These files should be printed and kept for handy reference. These file can be mailed in MSWord or text form.

These files are now on our web site at www.usatf.org/assoc/ok under Race Director's page.

Packet information is very helpful if you plan to have a high-quality race.

You can request a mailed packet. See the information below to contact us.

These emails/files contain the important information from the mailed packet and much of it is for new directors. If you are using a race service company, it can take care of many of the items listed in the mailed packet and those items that are being emailed to you.

USATF Oklahoma will email items of importance to race directors on a continuing basis and will also post these items on our web site.

Some directors are not sure about the USATF sanctioning and membership procedure so this is a good place to have all the information at your fingertips. Also, some of the directors have never done a race and are planning to do it on their own.

Remember, it is important to take a look at the USATF Oklahoma and USATF National websites at www.usatf.org/assoc/ok You should print the sanction and membership forms from this site for review and processing. The USATF Oklahoma officers and contacts, including phone numbers and emails, are listed on this site.

The four basic items for a high-quality race are: USATF sanction, USATF certified course, advertising in state publication, and reporting complete, accurate results to USATF Oklahoma.
