

APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF CERTIFIED COURSE

USATF course certifications expire automatically after ten years. Courses certified prior to 2001 may be renewed at the end of 10 years, although renewed courses are valid only until 20 years after the original certification or Dec. 31, 2011, whichever comes first. Courses certified in 2001 or later may not be renewed. Renewal requires comparing your course against its official RRTC certificate & map to verify that the course hasn't been changed and can still be located exactly. If you've lost the course's official certificate/map, you must obtain a copy before filling out this form! Copies of all certificates are available for \$2.00 apiece from the RRTC Course Registrar—Mike Wickiser, 2939 Vincent Road, Silver Lake, OH 44224; phone: (330) 929-1605 OR contact Bob Baumel or Joe McDaniel in Oklahoma. This renewal form may be filled out by the race director or race technical coordinator (i.e., person in charge of setting up the course on race day) or by the original course measurer if still present.
