Minutes of Meeting

The Youth Athletics Committees of Ozark District, AAU and Ozark Association, USATF held their Annual meeting on Sunday, August 20, 2006, at Missouri Baptist University, St. Louis, MO. The meeting was divided into two portions because of the differences in voting requirements of the two organizations.



Ozark Youth Athletics Director Laura Borman called the AAU portion of the meeting to order at 12:45 p.m. Following roll call (11 clubs were represented), the meeting agenda was approved. Minutes of the March 5 meeting were read and approved. A current financial report was received and approved. The schedule for 2006 Cross-Country competition was confirmed and a tentative 2007 Track & Field schedule was established. Kirkwood Track Club will host the 2006 Cross-Country meet. Bids were invited for the 2007 District T&F Championships. It was decided to shorten or eliminate the first weekend of the 2007 District Championships. A committee, chaired by Ken King, was appointed to set up an event schedule. Several issues with the Regional and National Championships were discussed and will be submitted to the National Youth Athletics Committee at the AAU Annual Meeting by Mrs. Borman. The AAU portion of the meeting adjourned at 1:15 p.m.



Ozark Youth Athletics Chair Laura Borman called the USATF portion of the meeting to order at 1:20 p.m. Ten voting members were present. Minutes of the 2006 Spring meeting were read and approved. A current financial report was received and approved. The schedule for 2006 Cross-Country competition was confirmed and a tentative 2007 Track & Field schedule was established. Bids were invited for the 2007 Association Track & Field championships. The following officers were elected for a two-year term beginning at once: Chair, Michael Beavers; Vice-Chair, Ann Mahone; Corresponding Secretary, Jim Duncan; Financial Secretary, Wanda McNeil. Jim Duncan reported on the progress of the USATF Coach and Volunteer Screening project. The Committee voted to host the 2007 Region IX Track & Field Championship.

Jim Duncan pointed out that the bylaws of both the (AAU) District and the (USATF) Association have been revised, making our youth bylaws for both obsolete. He plans to have an up-to-date version of each prepared for approval at the next meeting in February.

The next meeting of the Committees was set for Sunday, February 11, 2007, at Harris-Stowe University.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 2:45 p.m.
