### ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE

- Only citizens of the United States, eligible to compete under USATF Regulation 9 and IAAF Rules 51-54, who have met the published entry standards between May 5, 2000 and June 17, 2001 are eligible to compete in these Championships. Qualifying marks from indoor competitions must be attained on or after December 1, 2000.
- Foreign guest competitors and resident aliens, regardless of their membership in USA Track & Field are not eligible to compete.
- Female athletes must be 14 years or older and male athletes must be 16 years or older on the day of competition.
- All athletes must have a valid USATF membership card. USATF membership cards may be purchased through your local Association Office, the USATF National Office, or upon your arrival in Eugene. The cost at the event is \$15.

### ENTRY INFORMATION

To compete in the Championships, you must complete the entry process as follows:

- **An entry form must be submitted either by mail, fax, or on-line.**
- **The entry cost is \$15 per event.** The decathlon and heptathlon each count as one event. Fill out a separate entry blank for each event entered. All forms may be photocopied.
- **Entry by Mail** — All entries must be **POSTMARKED** by Monday, June 4, or **RECEIVED** by 6:30 p.m. PT on Monday, June 11. Make certified checks or money orders payable to: "Championships Organizing Committee."

- **Entry by Fax** — All faxed entries must be received at 541-687-1016 by 6:30 p.m. on Monday, June 11th. Faxed entries must be paid for by credit card. USATF prefers VISA.
- **Entry On-Line** — On-line entry is available through the [www.usatf.org](http://www.usatf.org) website. On-line entries must be paid by credit card. USATF prefers VISA.
- Athletes may enter an event(s) even if they have not yet met the qualifying standard for the event(s). However, athletes will not be permitted to compete unless they have: 1) completed the entry process, 2) met the standards by June 17, 2001, and 3) completed the declaration process.

Notification of entries received will be posted on the [usatf.org](http://usatf.org) and [eugenechamps.com](http://eugenechamps.com) websites.

- **Note — All entries must still be confirmed through the Declaration process.**
- **All entry fees are non-transferable and non-refundable, including those charged to credit cards using the on-line and fax entry options.**

**Late entries will be accepted if RECEIVED BEFORE 12 NOON PT Monday, June 18, 2001. Late entries must be accompanied by the \$15 per event fee, plus a fee of \$50 per event entered late.** Absolutely no entries will be accepted after this deadline. For overnight mailing of late entries requiring a street address for delivery, send c/o Northwest Event Management, Inc., 2300 Oakmont Way, Suite 211, Eugene, OR 97401.

While late entries will be accepted until 12 noon PT on Monday, June 18th, to avoid the late fee they must be postmarked by Monday, June 4, or received by Monday, June 11. Entries not received by June 11 will also not be listed in the souvenir program.

### DECLARATIONS PROCESS

Once properly entered, you must complete the declarations process as follows:

- **Each athlete or his/her representative must declare whether that athlete will or will not compete in each event they have entered. Declarations may be done by phone or in person ONLY.**
  - **Telephone declarations may be made by phoning 1-541-687-1989 on Monday, June 18 or Tuesday, June 19 from 10:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Pacific Time. NO COLLECT CALLS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
  - **In-Person declarations may be made at the Valley River Inn on Monday, June 18 or Tuesday, June 19 from 10:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Pacific Time.**
- When making a declaration, please be prepared to supply the following information:
  - Athlete's name
  - Name of declarer
  - Event(s) declaring for
  - Event(s) scratching
  - Best qualifying mark
  - When and where mark made, including name of meet (facility, city, and state), phone number (home and work, if available) and name of meet director
  - Phone numbers (day and night) and e-mail addresses of athlete and his/her coach/representative

At the time of declaration, you may update your qualifying performance. The burden of accuracy for all declarations will be on the athlete or his/her coach/representative. All entered marks will be checked and non-verifiable marks will not be honored.

- **Athletes who do not declare by June 19 at 5:00 p.m. PT will be scratched.**

**NOTE: Faxed or mailed declarations will not be accepted. ONLY in-person and telephone declarations will be accepted.**

- **Late Declarations** — Petitions for late declarations must be made to the Chair of the Men's or Women's Track & Field Committee or their designee. All such appeals must be accompanied by a non-refundable \$100.00 declaration fee.

ALL PETITIONS ARE DUE NO LATER THAN 12 NOON PACIFIC TIME, WEDNESDAY, JUNE 20TH.

## **RULES**

USA Track & Field rules shall apply. Protests must be filed in writing within 30 minutes of the results being announced and must be accompanied by a \$50 cash deposit, refundable only if the protest is upheld.

## **DEFENDING IAAF 1999 WORLD OUTDOOR CHAMPIONS**

The IAAF has announced that all defending champions in individual events from the 1999 IAAF World Outdoor Track & Field Championships have been granted a waiver to participate in that same event at the 2001 IAAF World Outdoor Track & Field Championships, subject to being entered in the World Championships by their respective National Governing Body. Related to the above, USA Track & Field's Board of Directors has approved a policy that in order for the 1999 World Championship Defending Champion to be entered by USA Track & Field, the athlete must have competed in the 2001 GMC Envoy USA Outdoor Track & Field Championships, unless excused by the appropriate Sports Committee Chair for injury or other valid reasons.

## **DRUG TESTING**

Athletes who participate in this competition may be subject to drug testing in accordance with the IAAF Procedural Guidelines for Doping Control or the Olympic Movement Anti-Doping Code. Drug testing, and the adjudication of positive findings, will be carried out by the United States Anti-Doping Agency (USADA). Athletes found to have committed a doping violation will be disciplined according to the USADA Protocol and suspended, if appropriate, according to applicable IAAF rules. Such penalties may result in a period of ineligibility as well as disqualification from the event. Any substance taken by an athlete is at his/her own risk and may result in a positive sample. (This includes cold medicines, nutritional supplements, and some over the counter medicines). - Additional all-session "Athlete Support" credentials may be purchased by the athlete for his/her representatives, coaches, and/or personal health care providers for \$50 per credential. ## IMPLEMENTS

Implements for all field events will be provided by the Local Organizing Committee.

## SHUTTLE BUSES

- Shuttles will run from the Valley River Inn and Gateway hotel areas to and from Hayward Field from Wednesday through Sunday of the Championships. On competition days, these shuttles will start at least two hours before the first event each day, and conclude one hour after the last event.
- Shuttles will be for the exclusive use of athletes, coaches, officials and media. A valid Championships pass will be necessary to gain admittance to the bus.
- No airport shuttle service is provided.

## AWARDS

USA Track & Field medals will be awarded to the top 6 in each event. There will be an awards ceremony shortly following the conclusion of each event.

## MEDICAL SERVICES

A full complement of medical professionals will be available at Hayward Field during the Championships, including MDs, massage therapists, chiropractors, and trainers. If you have any particular questions, contact the Organizing Committee. Personal therapists/trainers with an Athlete Support credential may set up on the infield of the practice track.

## NATIONAL TEAM SELECTION

The following teams will be selected from these Championships:

**World Championships, Edmonton, Alberta, August 2-12** – Men & Women, 3 athletes per event, plus relay personnel.  
All athletes must have met World Championships qualifying standards.

**Goodwill Games, Brisbane, Australia, September 4-7** — Men & Women, selection criteria to be determined.

**World University Games** – Men & Women, 2 university student -athletes per event, who meet the eligibility requirements.

**USA vs. Germany Decathlon, Frankfurt or Stuttgart, Germany, July 21-22** – 7 male decathletes

## PASSPORTS

If you qualify for an international team for competition outside of the United States, a passport will be required and **must** be brought with you to the GMC Envoy USA Outdoor Track & Field Championships in order to facilitate processing. If you do not currently have a valid passport, you are urged to obtain one and bring it with you to Eugene.

### QUALIFYING GUIDELINES

1. All qualifying performances for running events must be made on a standard indoor or outdoor track.
2. Qualifying marks must be made and verifiable in one of the following: 1) USATF or IAAF sanctioned events; 2) collegiate meets; 3) high school meets.
3. All qualifying marks from outdoor competitions must be attained on or after Friday, May 5, 2000, through Sunday, June 17, 2001. Qualifying marks from indoor competitions must be attained on or after Friday, December 1, 2000.
4. A 3% altitude allowance on the standard is permitted for track events of 1500 meters or longer, contested at a facility 4000 feet, or more, above sea level.
5. A manual time may only be used for qualifying in running events 800 meters or longer and only if fully automatic timing does not exist for the race. A manual time may not supersede any fully automatic qualifying time for an event, and must be approved by the Chair of the appropriate Sport Committee.
6. Times submitted in hundredths of a second must be fully automatic times.
7. In the GMC Envoy USA Outdoor Track & Field Championships, all entered contestants must have met the qualifying standards adopted by the respective Sport Committee or by the properly authorized subcommittee thereof and listed on the entry blank, or must be approved by a special subcommittee appointed by the Chair of the respective Sport Committee. Petitions to said special subcommittee must be presented in writing.
8. Any athlete who has, in the current year or during the four previous calendar years, earned an individual medal in track and field in the Olympic Games or in an IAAF World Indoor or Outdoor Championships, or in the previous year, won an individual USA Senior Outdoor Championships event, shall be afforded automatic qualification into all USA Senior Indoor and Outdoor Track and Field Championships and Olympic Trials in the same event in which the athlete won the medal or championship.
9. Race Walking. Any athlete who has, in the current year or during the four previous calendar years, in a race walking event (1) earned an individual medal in an Olympic Games or an IAAF World Indoor or Outdoor Championships, (2) won an individual Championship at the USA Senior Indoor or Outdoor Track Championships, (3) won a USA Championship in the 50-kilometer Walk, or (4) won a USA Olympic Trials, shall be afforded automatic qualification into all USA Senior Indoor and Outdoor Championships and Olympic Trials in a race walking event of his or her choice.
