QUALIFICATION and FEES

The first 20 finishers and the first three teams in each age division for both boys and girls in the regional competitions qualify for the National Championships. The entry fee for the Nationals is \$6.00 per individual, non refundable, and must be submitted with the entry forms at the Regionals. Important! Regional Coordinators shall forward ALL QUALIFYING ENTRY FORMS and COMPLETE RESULTS to the National Championship Meet Organizer by expedient methods-such as EXPRESS MAIL or some form of air courier (i.e. FEDERAL EXPRESS)-within 48 hours of the Regional. No late entrants or additions to the official roster submitted by the Regional Coordinator will be accepted by telephone or from an athlete, parent, or coach.

GENERAL EVENT INFORMATION

Welcome to Carrollton, Georgia! A unique blend of small-town charm in a University setting, a vibrant economy, and visionary leadership makes the residents proud to call this home. Carrollton has a diverse industrial base, plenty of southern hospitality, and provides all of the advantages of this lifestyle less than an hour away from the

Metropolitan Center of the South, Atlanta.

Your Official Meet Headquarters is the Carrollton Elementary School Gymnasium located on the backside of the school on W.B Fulbright Street. This is site of packet pick-up. The opening ceremonies will be held at Carrollton High School Stadium just across the Street from the Course. The awards ceremony is located at East Carrollton Recreation Center at 410 N. Lake Drive just 1.5 miles from the Course.

TOURIST INFORMATION

Carrollton has a new Cultural Arts Center on Alabama Street, a few yards from historic Adamson Square, a Christmas Parade through downtown and other seasonal events ongoing to provide activities away from the Cross Country Course. Visit the Carrollton Convention & Visitors Website's "tour guide of the city" at www.visitcarrollton.com If you need additional things to do, the short drive to Atlanta will provide just about all of the entertainment you could ask for a weekend. A brochure with coupons and activities in Atlanta will be in your packet at packet pickup.

PACKET PICKUP

Packet pickup will be at the Carrollton Elementary School Gymnasium on Thursday, December 12, between the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and Friday, December 13, between the hours of 9:00a.m.to 9:00 p.m. On Saturday, December 14, packet pickup will open at 7:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. All team members should have packets picked up together, not individually.

WEATHER

The weather in Carrollton in December is usually sunny and cool. The average low for December 14 is 35 Degrees and the average high is 58 Degrees. The average rainfall for December is 4.23 inches.

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

If you are driving to Carrollton, we are located approximately 45 miles from Atlanta and 110 miles from Birmingham. Carrollton is just off Interstate 20, and is only 50 miles west from Interstate 75 and Interstate 85.

Directions: FROM ATLANTA, GA- Take I-20 West, pass Six Flags, to Exit 24 Carrollton/Villa Rica (GA-61/GA-101). Turn left at the end of the exit ramp toward

Carrollton. Travel to the Carrollton City limits. Pass Ryan's Steak House on right, immediately merge to left lane. Turn left on GA 166- By- Pass. Go 4 miles. Pass under US 27 Over-pass. At next light, Turn right on Ben Scott Blvd. The starting line of the Course is on right. FROM NEWNAN GA,- Take Highway GA 27ALT/ GA 16 North toward Carrollton. Turn Left on GA 166 BY-Pass. Turn right on Ben Scott Blvd.

There will be ample parking available at the course. Volunteer staff will direct you to all open parking areas.

The LOC has designated Delta Airlines as *their official airline* of the 2002 JO Cross Country Championship. Delta has agreed to give a discount to all athletes. You can receive a 5% discount on the lowest fare available. If you call 60 days from your flight date you can receive 10%. Please call 1-800-241-6760. Car Rentals can also be made through National Car Rental, *the LOC's official car rental agency* for the Championships. Special rates are available from economy through luxury size vehicles including 8 to 15 passenger vans. You can receive a discount rate by calling 1-800-227-7368

There will be no shuttle bus service. You are responsible for making your own ground travel arrangements (again, National Car Rental is the official car rental agency of the championships).

THE COURSE

The Course Location is less than 3/4 of a mile from the Carrollton hotels, and 20 minutes to Douglasville hotels. The travel time from the Metro-Atlanta area is less than one hour. The course has been the site for the State High School Cross Country Championship and many other high school and youth competitions. The course is challenging with rolling hills, wooded areas, and sharp turns. The course is primarily grass, but competitors will cross one section of a road covered with a Mondo track surface. It is recommended that spiked shoes are worn. The start and finish are

within 300 meters of each other and the course loops out and back several times allowing you several opportunities to easily view the runners. There are speakers throughout the course so that both athletes and spectators can hear all announcements. Be advised this is a closed course, and spectators are required to stay within the fenced-off areas.

THE STARTING LINE

Each region will have a Designated Starting Box at the Starting Line for each race. The arrangements for the starting assignments will be different from age-group to age-group and race-to-race and are determined by a random drawing. The method of starting will be the whistle, flag, and pistol method described in the NCAA and National Federation of High School Rule Book.

WARM-UP AND STAGING AREAS

The Warm-Up and Staging Areas will be designated by signs and will be accessible only by the athletes who are competing. Please observe all areas that are roped off and please obey all course moni-

tor directions. Athletes will be asked to report to the Staging Area approximately 30 minutes prior to the start of their race.

SPECTATOR AREA

Spectators are encouraged to watch the races from several locations on the course. However, there are areas that will not be accessible to spectators and you are asked to please honor all roped off areas as being "out-of-bounds" to spectators. Course Marshals will be at many locations throughout the course making sure that athletes and spectators honor the boundaries that are established. The course will be open to the public on Friday, December 13 from 9 a.m. until 4 p.m. and Saturday, December 14 from 7 a.m. until 9 a.m. at which time it will be closed to everyone except meet officials, course marshals, and meet photographers. Violations of these boundaries may result in the disqualification of an athlete or a team.

TEAM UNIFORMS

Each competitor in the team competition must have a jersey or singlet that is basically identical in color and style for each member and must be clearly

visible throughout the race. This means that the team jersey must be worn on the outer layer if other garments are worn during the race. Athletes competing "unattached," or not in the team competition, will have the choice of any apparel item they choose, so long as the outer garment has the athlete's race bib attached to it.

Each athlete will have a Bib Number which designates her/his age division. The athlete must have the bib number attached to the clothes they will be racing in when they check in at the Staging Area. Numbers are to be worn ON THE FRONT. Each bib number will have pull tab at the bottom of the bib, please DO NOT REMOVE THE PULL TAB. Please DO NOT ATTACH the pull tab on the bib number to your jersey or to the outer layer of your race clothing. Each athlete will have 2 matching Hip Numbers which you must pin to your hip. There will be a \$10.00 charge to replace lost or misplaced race bib numbers.

Dressing Facilities are not available at the course, so competitors should arrive in racing uniforms and warm-ups. Portable restrooms will be available around the facility.

FIRST AID

In the event of injuries, First Aid

treatment will be available at the meet site in a tent near the finish line area. First Aid will be administered by a large group of volunteer health care professionals. Tanner Medical Center is only a mile from the Course.

PROTEST

A Protest Table will be available and all protests must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the posting of the results for each race. The protest fee is \$100.00 which will be returned if the protest is upheld.

OPENING CEREMONIES

The Opening Ceremony will be held at 6:00 p.m. Friday December 13th, at the Carrollton High School Stadium. You can walk across the street from the course to this event. All athletes should arrive at 5:30 and report to your region banners in the Stadium. This event is outside, please dress warm. If inclement weather occurs, we will move to the East Carrollton Recreation Center.

LODGING

Lodging: The following Carrollton, Georgia Area hotels have set up room blocks for the USA Track & Field – National Junior Olympic Cross Country

Championships. The room blocks have been set-up for the convenience of athletes, fans and family in making room reservations.

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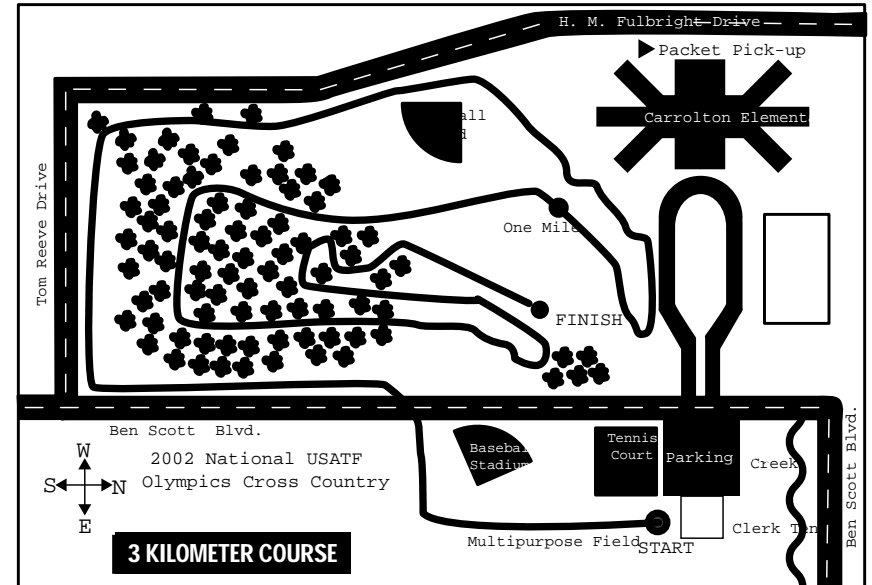

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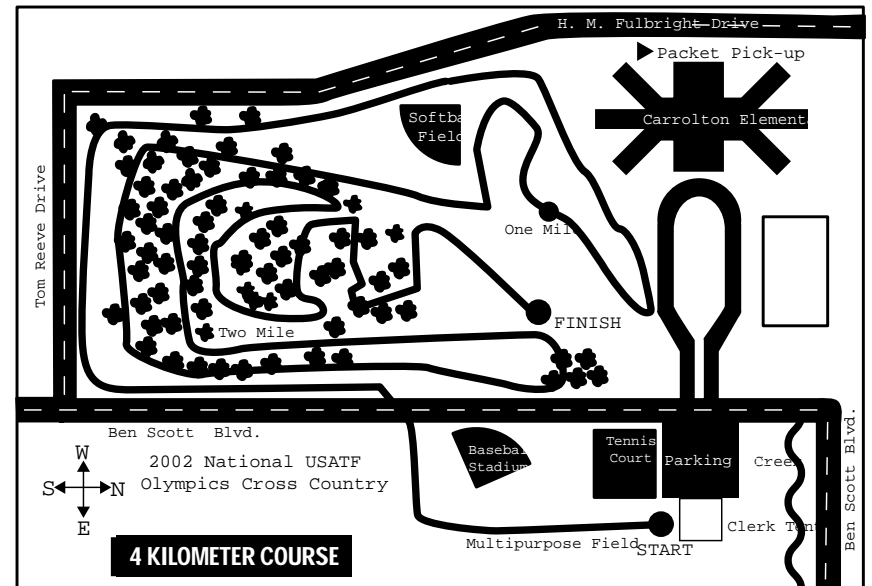

RULES

RULE 244 NATIONAL CROSS COUNTRY PROGRAM

1. General

The Youth Athletics Committee shall conduct cross country for all divisions in the USATF Youth Athletics program. Divisions shall be as set forth in Rule 240.1(b). National Championships may be conducted as directed by the Cross Country Subcommittee upon approval of the Youth Athletics Committee.

2. Distances

The Bantam and Midget divisions shall run approximately 3 kilometers. The Youth division shall run approximately 4 kilometers. The Intermediate and Young Men's/Women's divisions shall run approximately 5 kilometers.

Qualification Rule for National Junior Olympics (Rule 245-3)

Where an Association holds preliminary meets, these will serve as qualifiers for its Championships; Association Championships are qualifiers for Regional Championships, and the Regionals are qualifiers for the Nationals.

(a) It is suggested that 25 individuals and 3 teams advance from preliminary meets to Association meets and a like number of individuals and teams advance from Association meets to Regional meets. These numbers may be adjusted by the Association chair and Regional coordinator respec-

tively for the purpose of accommodating their local situations.

(b) Teams must represent current USATF member clubs; and athletes representing clubs must be registered members of said clubs prior to participation in their Association Championships.

(c) All members of the same club listed on the team declaration roster at the Association finals are eligible to compete on the club's team (minimum of 5, maximum of 8) in the next round of Qualifications up to and including the National Championships as long as the team qualifies. At the National meet, team members shall be declared at least 1 1/2 hours prior to the scheduled start of the event.

(d) A region, through a unanimous vote of Associations in the region, shall determine the procedure for qualifying from the Regional to the National Junior Olympics cross country championships. The regions may vote for one, but not both, of the following means of qualifying: (i) qualify the top three (3) teams and the top 20 individuals from the regional meet, or (ii) qualify the top team and the top ten (10) individuals directly from the Association Championship. (e) The number of qualifiers from Regional meets is fixed and no alternates may advance. Individuals finishing in the top twenty (20) places and who are also members of the qualifying teams are not displaced so that

additional finishers beyond twentieth may not advance. Any team may advance if it has five (5) or more individuals placing in the top twenty (20) in the Regional meet. No team finishing beyond third place may advance based solely upon either or both of the first two teams' choosing not to advance.

Proof of Birthdate and USATF Registration

A copy of PROOF OF AGE or age verification stamp and USATF MEMBERSHIP NUMBER must be provided with the official entry. If they are not provided, a \$10.00 processing fee for each not provided will be assessed at time of packet pickup. NOTE: A copy of computer generated USATF card with D.O.B. verification association membership chair will be accepted.

Entry Procedures & Rules (Rule 245-4)

(c) National Championships qualifiers must file their entry forms for the Nationals on the day of their Regional Championships. Entry forms for the Nationals will therefore be supplied to Association meet directors by the national office (with shipment of their medal orders) in a quantity sufficient to enable distribution of one copy to each athlete qualifying for the Regionals. This will make it possible for athletes intending to compete in the Nationals to

have completed entry forms on hand at their Regionals—including such documentation as USATF membership number, copy of birth certification (birth certificate, certified baptismal record, driver's license, passport or U.S. military identification), and Nationals entry fee. Complete instructions on this procedure are to be found on Page 2 of the USATF Junior Olympic Cross Country Awards Request Application.

AWARDS CEREMONY

The Awards Ceremony will be held at 7:00 p.m. at the East Carrollton Recreation Center. The top 25 finishers in each race will receive a USATF medal as well as a plaque recognizing their "All-American" status. The top three teams in each division will receive a team plaque and each team member will be honored with a medal. Please keep your Bib Number for Your Special Award. Also, as part of the Verizon Youth Series, the top male and female performers will be honored with special "Verizon Athlete of the Meet" awards.

RESULTS

Results for each race will be posted on boards in several locations at the course. Please do not remove these posted results as there will be many athletes and their families looking for the results. Complete results for all of the races will be available in booklet form for \$5.00 and will be sold at the awards ceremony at the East Carrollton Recreation Center.

PHOTOGRAPHY

The meet photographer is Action Sports Images of Kansas City, Missouri (asiphoto@kc.rr.com) Their crew will cover the course at the Carrollton High School Course from a number of different angles. They also will take both individual and team pictures at the Award Ceremony.

ATHLETES VILLAGE

Want to take something home to remember your experience at the Championships? Event merchandise designed specifically for the Junior Olympics Cross Country Championships; including long- and short-sleeved T-shirts, sweatshirts, hats, pins and other memorabilia will be on sale at the Carrollton Elementary Gymnasium during packet-pick-up, at Booths in the Village at the Races, and at the Award Ceremony.
