Level 1, Level 2, Level 3 Schools & Instructor Training Course University of Nevada – Las Vegas

- Level 1** – The Level 1 program covers all events, emphasizing fundamentals, rules, safety/risk management, and instruction techniques.
- Level 2** – Level 2 is for those who have successfully completed Level 1 prior to January 31, 2006 and wish to gain a stronger knowledge base in a specialized event area.
- Level 3** – Also called “Advanced Coaching Summits,” Level 3 programs are scientific, knowledge-based seminars intending to provide coaches with comprehensive knowledge in a specific event group, including sport science and training theory.
- ITC** – ITC is for Level 2 coaches who wish to become Level 1 Instructors.

LEVEL 2 EVENT OPTIONS (UNLV):

JUMPS – High Jump, Long Jump, Triple Jump, Pole Vault (max. 50 students)

THROWS – Shot, Discus, Javelin, Hammer (max. 35 students)

SPRINTS – Sprints, Hurdles, Relays (max. 50 students)

ENDURANCE – 800m – 10,000m and Race Walking (max. 50 students)

COMBINED EVENTS – Decathlon, Heptathlon (max. 25 students)

All applicants (including alumni) must submit the following along with this application:

1. Provide a brief (two pages maximum) resume or vita, which includes pertinent information regarding your personal athletic experience, all coaching positions held, and any related activities (e.g., camps, clinics, publications, presentations). Include the names and addresses of three individuals as references.
2. Provide a one-page outline of your approach to coaching or developing athletes in the event group for which you have applied.
3. Notification of Acceptance will be done via email within three weeks of receiving the application. Acceptance is based on qualifications and not on a “first come first served” basis, however each event group will be closed once maximum group size is reached.

All Level 2 applications for the 2006 UNLV program must be postmarked before June 1, 2006.

Do Not send fee with this application. Fee must be paid in full within two weeks of acceptance into the school or spot will be forfeited. Refer to the registration form for fee and late fee information.

Alumni School applicants to Level 2 schools: To qualify for Alumni School, one must have completed at least one area of Level 2. Alumni participants do not have to repeat the Sports Science section of Level 2 school.

The Advanced Coaching Summits are open to anyone wishing to attend; previous completion of a Level 1 or Level 2 school is not required. However, in order for participation in this program to count toward your Level 3 certificate, coaches must have completed the entire Level 2 program in advance. There is no pre-determined limit on the number of participants in the advanced summits; however, facility limitations may require class limits. Applicants are encouraged to apply early to secure their place.
