Level 1 – The Level 1 program covers all events, emphasizing fundamentals, rules, safety/risk management, and instruction techniques.

Level 2 – Level 2 is for those who have successfully completed Level 1 prior to January 31, 2006 and wish to gain a stronger knowledge base in a specialized event area.

LEVEL 2 EVENT OPTIONS (JMU):
JUMPS – High Jump, Long, Jump Triple Jump, Pole Vault (max. 50 students)
THROWS – Shot, Discus, Javelin, Hammer (max. 35 students)
SPRINTS – Sprints, Hurdles, Relays (max. 50 students)
ENDURANCE – 800m – 10,000m and Race Walking (max. 50 students)
COMBINED EVENTS – Decathlon, Heptathlon (max. 25 students)

All Level 2 applicants (including alumni) must submit the following along with this application:

1. Provide a brief (two pages maximum) resume or vita, which includes pertinent information regarding your personal athletic experience, all coaching positions held, and any related activities (e.g., camps, clinics, publications, presentations). Include the names and addresses of three individuals as references.
2. Provide a one-page outline of your approach to coaching or developing athletes in the event group for which you have applied.
3. Notification of Acceptance will be done via email and/or postal mail within three weeks of receiving the application. Acceptance is based on qualifications and not on a “first come first served” basis, however each event group will be closed once maximum group size is reached.

All Level 2 applications for the 2006 JMU program must be postmarked on or before June 29, 2006.

*Level 2 Applicants: Do Not send fee with this application. Fee must be paid in full within two weeks of acceptance into the school or spot will be forfeited. Refer to the registration form for fee and late fee information. **Level 1 applicants should send their fee with their application (make checks payable to USATF).***

Alumni School applicants to Level 2 schools: To qualify for Alumni School, one must have completed at least one area of Level 2. Alumni participants do not have to repeat the Sports Science section of Level 2 school.
