**Level 2** – Level 2 is for those who have successfully completed Level 1 prior to January 31, 2007 and wish to gain a stronger knowledge base in a specialized event area. Go to <http://www.usatf.org/groups/Coaches/education/level2.asp> for a complete listing of the Level 2 eligibility requirements.

**Advanced Summits** – These programs are scientific, knowledge-based seminars intending to provide coaches with comprehensive knowledge in a specific event group. Level 3 credit is awarded to participants who have already completed Level 2.

**Instructor Training Course (ITC)** – The ITC is open to Level 2 certified coaches who wish to become eligible to instruct in the Level 1 program

### LEVEL 2 EVENT OPTIONS

**JUMPS** – High Jump, Long Jump, Triple Jump, Pole Vault (max. 60 students)

**THROWS** – Shot, Discus, Javelin, Hammer (max. 35 students)

**SPRINTS** – Sprints, Hurdles, Relays (max. 60 students)

**ENDURANCE** – 800m – 10,000m and Race Walking (max. 60 students)

**COMBINED EVENTS** – Decathlon, Heptathlon (max. 25 students)

**ITC** – Level 1 instructor training program (max 20 students)

### 2007 Advanced Summit Options

**JUMPS      SPRINTS      ENDURANCE**  
**A maximum of 150 participants per event group will be admitted.**

The Advanced Coaching Summits are open to anyone wishing to attend; no previous completion of a USATF Coaching Education Program is required. However, in order for participation in this program to count toward completion of the Level 3 requirements, coaches must have already completed at least one area of Level 2. A maximum of 150 participants will be admitted into each Advanced Summit therefore applicants are encouraged to apply early to secure a spot.

**All applicants (including alumni) must submit the following along with this application:**

1. Provide a brief (two pages maximum) resume or vita, which includes pertinent information regarding your personal athletic experience, all coaching positions held, and any related activities (e.g., camps, clinics, publications, presentations). Include the names and addresses of three individuals as references.
2. Provide a one-page outline of your approach to coaching or developing athletes in the event group for which you have applied.

**All Level 2 applications for the 2007 Level 2 program must be postmarked before June 1, 2007.**

**Alumni School** applicants to Level 2 schools: To qualify for Alumni School, one must have completed at least one area of Level 2. Alumni participants do not have to repeat the Sports Science section of Level 2 School.

**Housing and Meal Plan:** An optional housing and meal plan is available to those applicants who apply and are accepted ***BEFORE*** May 27, 2007. The early housing and meal plan deadline is necessary because USATF must provide Loyola University the final count of rooms and meal plans needed no later than May 23rd. **Early Registration Discount:** Applications postmarked on or before May 12 will not be assessed the \$50 late registration fee. The prices listed on the next page reflect the early registration fees.

**Fee Payment:** All applications must be accompanied by payment in full. USATF accepts checks, money orders and VISA. VISA is the only credit card accepted by USATF. Checks will be returned in the event that an applicant is not accepted into the program. Applications with credit card numbers will be destroyed.

***Notification of Acceptance will be done via email and/or postal mail within three weeks of receiving the application. Acceptance is based on qualifications and not on a "first come first served" basis, however each event group will be closed once maximum group size is reached.***
