After TikTok's release in the US, many celebrities started posting their own TikTok clips of themselves dancing, eating, hanging out with their friends and other activities. According to USA Today, by December 2023, over 200k+ Star was posting TikTok videos of themselves. An analysis by The Verge found that these celebrity TikTok clips were downloaded 2-4 million times each day across 10 different countries; even in countries where Instagram was banned. Celebrities including Kylie Jenner, Nicki Minaj, Harry Styles and Justin Bieber have been given official TikTok accounts by the company due to their popular video content on the platform.",

The app is being directly blamed for a number of deaths in China and increased levels of teen depression and self-harm. Some users have been found posting self-harm images on TikTok. There are concerns the app is also being used for illegal drug sales and sex trafficking. There are a number of videos featuring young people openly discussing drug use and buying and selling drugs on the platform. The content of these videos allows potential buyers to easily connect with the dealers via direct messaging to organise drug purchases.",

In the Middle East, TikTok has been partnered with local governments such as Qatar's Department of Culture and Information (QDCI) to allow citizens and tourists alike to enjoy the app. In March 2023, Zain Saudi Arabia began a partnership with TikTok as part of their "Rubiq" campaign that aimed to use the app to educate people about proper manners in public spaces. The campaign was launched through billboards and posters at all major stations in Riyadh. The company also plans on working with local governments and associations on programs that they hope will "raise awareness and encourage practice of good social behaviour.",

On May 28, 2023, Musical.ly filed a lawsuit against Snapchat for using content from the musical.ly service without permission. The lawsuit claimed that Snapchat had downloaded and used musical.ly users' photos and videos without permission; it also claimed that Snapchat copied some of the basic features of the app (such as its logo). In response to Musical.ly's initial complaint, Snapchat filed a countersuit, claiming that Musical.ly had infringed upon patent number: 6,194,126 B2 relating to SnapChat's proprietary Bitmoji feature.",

On February 29, 2023, the city of Seattle passed a law requiring its public transit agencies to stop promoting digital media products and services that may be distracting for riders or drivers. Public transportation agencies in Seattle are prevented by the law from using statistics

TikTok has been criticised for allowing profanity in some of its videos, as well as encouraging some of its videos to be posted publicly. This is because casual profanity does not have the same impact or consequence in Chinese culture as it would otherwise have in English or American culture. There are many examples of offensive, inappropriate or dangerous behaviour on TikTok, and some users have found it difficult to identify when this behaviour is acceptable and when it is not. Some of this behaviour could be seen as encouraging users to behave in a similar way if they are in a similar situation."

Following the official announcement of TikTok's global release on December 9, 2021, the app became immensely popular due to its widely popular features and user base. From July 5th onwards, the app's userbase increased greatly due to many people seeing it as a way to connect with friends within their country and all across the world through videos and more."

In May 2021, it was reported that TikTok removed approximately 175 million videos between January and May of that year. As of June 2021 TikTok has removed more than a billion videos, which is 10 times the amount of views in that time period. On top of the time and monetary costs associated with removing content, it can result in the loss of advertising revenue for creators who could lose loyal followers due to annoyance from account closures."
